What is Google Classroom

Think of Google Classroom as digital access to your child's classroom.

Teachers use Google Classroom to share presentations, videos, and receive work from students. It also provides a link for the Google Meet needed to virtually join class through video.

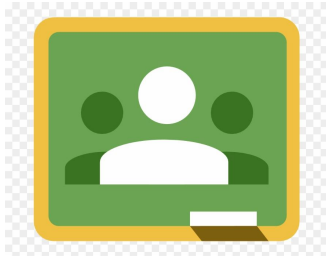


How to Log In

How to Begin in Google Classroom

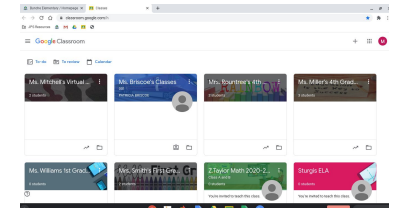
1. Click on the icon for Google Classroom at the bottom of the screen. It looks like a green chalkboard with people.



How to Begin Class

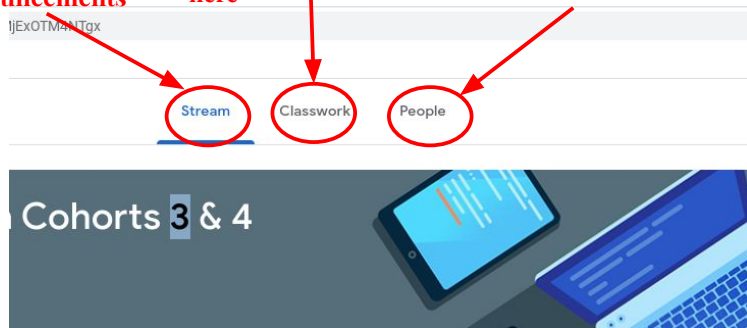
1. Click on the class you wish to begin.

You may have to click “Join” before entering. If a code is provided by the teacher instead, click the + sign at the top right to join a class.

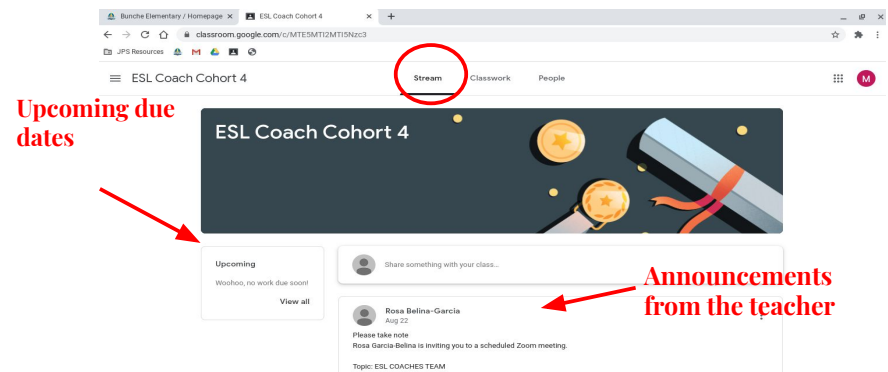


The Three Tabs to Google Classroom at the Top of the Page

Tabs: Stream Find upcoming due dates, announcements, and Google Meet link here.

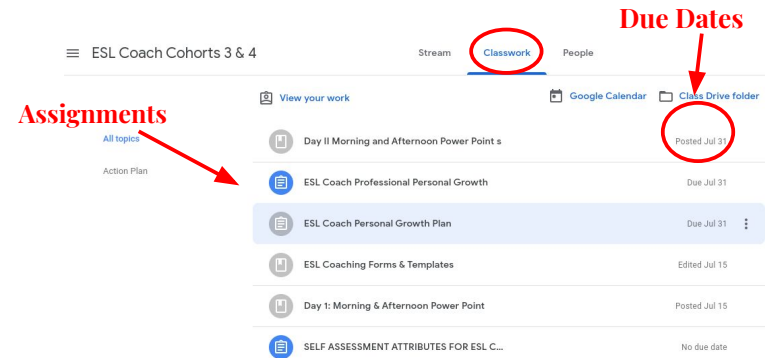


Tabs: Stream- How to Log In to Google Meet for Class****

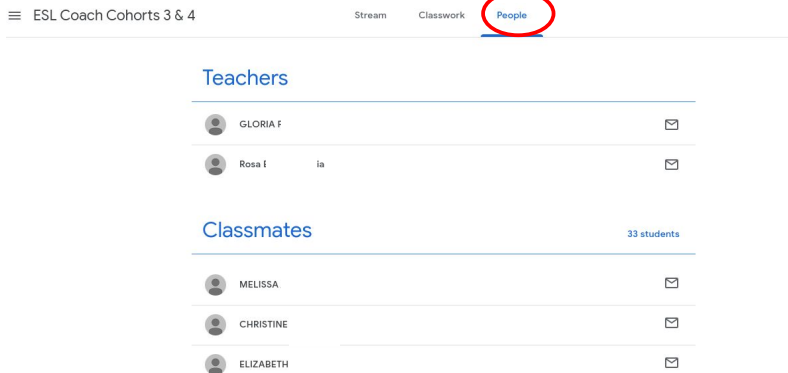
Click the Meet link here by 7:30 for class (It is under "Stream").

Tabs: People See a list of other students and teachers here.



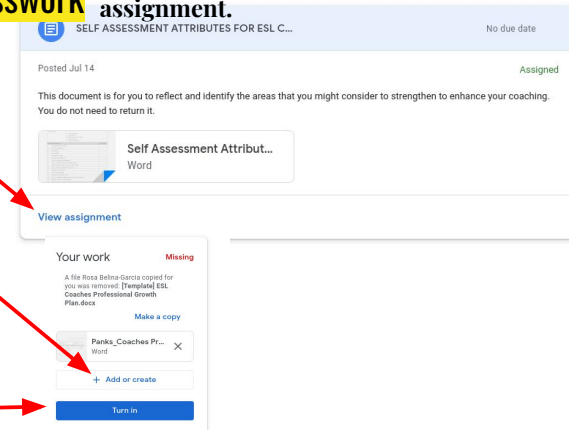
View/Turn in Classwork
