Applications must be completed, including all required documents to be reviewed and confirmed for testing. The testing time, date and location selected during the application process will be reviewed and confirmed by the ASA admissions office before the testing date.



Documents Required to Qualify for Admissions Testing

APPLYING FOR PRE-K–GRADE 1:

- To attend Pre-K, a student must be 4 years old on or before **September 30, 2022**, as verified by an attached copy of the birth certificate.
- To attend kindergarten, a student must be 5 years old on or before **September 30, 2022**, as verified by an attached copy of the birth certificate.
- All students applying for Pre-K through 1st grade must submit a copy of the birth certificate.
- Proof of residency in Jefferson Parish - All students applying for Pre-K through grade 1 must provide:
 - Identification – Parent/Guardian Driver's License, State-Issued ID or Passport
 - Proof of residency in Jefferson Parish – current utility bill, car registration or other official documentation.

APPLYING FOR GRADES 2–5:

- A copy of the most recent report card must be attached.
- A student's age must be verified by an attached copy of the birth certificate.
- Proof of residency in Jefferson Parish - All students applying for grades 2-5 must provide:
 - Identification – Parent/Guardian Driver's License, State-Issued ID or Passport
 - Proof of residency in Jefferson Parish – current utility bill, car registration or other official documentation.

APPLYING FOR GRADES 6–12

- Proof of residency in Jefferson Parish - All students applying for grades 6-12 must provide:
 - Identification – Parent/Guardian Driver's License, State-Issued ID or Passport
 - Proof of residency in Jefferson Parish – current utility bill, car registration or other official documentation.
- Report cards - For students entering grades six through twelve, in addition to submitting the parent's/guardian's proof of residency in Jefferson Parish, a copy of the student's birth certificate and the student's final report cards from the last two school years must also be submitted with the application. The student's end of year report card for the last two years must demonstrate a final GPA of 2.5 in reading, English, language arts, math, science, and social studies courses attempted.
