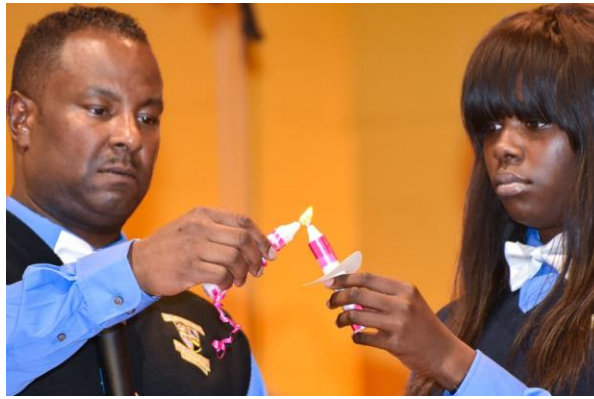

JPS 9th Grade School Choice Opportunity General Information

- A student's zoned school is the school in the boundary area based on the enrolling parent's home address. A student's choice school is the one for which is applied to attend outside of the boundary area.
- Only students wishing to change schools need to apply for School Choice. Completing an application does not guarantee assignment to a Choice School.



- Students may only apply to attend a choice high school during their 8th grade year. Students may not submit an application for choice after the approved application period. ***Students eligible to participate must be in 8th Grade and enrolled in a Jefferson Parish School System operated school for the 2021-22 School Year.
- Choice assignments are good through the 12th grade.
- Applications for school Choice will be considered based the number of seats approved by the district.
- Choice preference is given to district employee's children* and students of active-duty military personnel. Official documentation is required to receive preference. Choice preference does not guarantee assignment to a Choice School.



- The Choice plan guarantees placement of siblings within the same school if capacity allows. Official documentation is required to receive preference.
- Waitlist process: Students who are not placed at their choice school during the notification period, will be placed on the waitlist. The wait list will remain active until the 15th day of school. After the 15th day of school, no student will be moved as a choice student.
- **Transportation is not provided to students who receive a choice placement.**
- Students who receive a choice transfer shall be ineligible to participate in interscholastic athletics at that school for a period of one calendar year from his/her first day of attendance. Students should see their counselor or athletic director for more information.
