Applications must be completed, including all required documents to be submitted for review by the deadline of May 27, 2024 at 5:00 p.m. to be confirmed for testing. The testing time, date, and location assigned during the application process will be confirmed by the ASA Admissions office before the testing date.



Documents Required to Qualify for Summer Admissions Testing

APPLYING FOR PRE-K–GRADE 2:

- ❑ To attend Pre-K, a student must be 4 years old on or before **September 30, 2024**, as verified by an uploaded copy of the birth certificate.
- ❑ To attend kindergarten, a student must be 5 years old on or before **September 30, 2024**, as verified by an uploaded copy of the birth certificate.
- ❑ All students applying for Pre-K through 2nd grade must submit a copy of the birth certificate.
- ❑ Proof of residency in Jefferson Parish - All students applying for Pre-K through grade 2 must provide:
 - Identification – Parent/Guardian Driver's License, State-Issued ID or Passport
 - Proof of residency in Jefferson Parish – current utility bill, car registration or other official documentation.
- ❑ For Summer Admissions, student applicants must not have been tested during the Fall 2024-2025 application window.

APPLYING FOR GRADES 3–8:

- ❑ A copy of the most recent report card must be uploaded.
- ❑ A student's age must be verified by an uploaded copy of the birth certificate.
- ❑ Proof of residency in Jefferson Parish - All students applying for grades 3-8 must provide:
 - Identification – Parent/Guardian Driver's License, State-Issued ID or Passport
 - Proof of residency in Jefferson Parish – current utility bill, car registration or other official documentation.

*Students applying for grades 3 and higher who score a minimum of 75 on the admissions test will have to demonstrate some proficiency in the French language by meeting the required level on a peer normed proficiency test. This will ensure that a student entering 3rd grade or higher will have sufficient ability in French to join the French language class at his or her grade level.

- ❑ For Summer Admissions, student applicants must not have been tested during the Fall 2024-2025 application window.
