Chaperone Guidelines

To All Field Trip Chaperones:

We would like to thank you for taking the time to be a part of your child's education. Field Trips can be a wonderful experience for all who participate, including chaperones. Your assistance allows additional supervision to help ensure safety and the most beneficial learning opportunity available.

The following guidelines must be followed by all chaperones:

- 1) Please dress appropriately and comfortably. Midriffs and "short" shorts are not allowed. There is usually a lot of walking, so wear walking shoes or tennis shoes.
- 2) All chaperones must stay with their group leader or with the coordinating teacher. For the safety of all, no one is allowed to wander off from the group. In an emergency, please notify coordinating teacher if you need to leave.
- 3) Smoking is prohibited while chaperoning field trips.
- 4) We ask that parents do not buy additional items (food, drinks, toys) for their child(ren) or themselves. We would like all children to have an equally exciting experience.
- 5) Chaperones are not allowed to bring other children who are not in the designated field trip class. (Example: Siblings younger than school age, siblings who attend other schools).
- 6) Chaperones must be of legal age (21 years).
