We are prepared for a digital learning environment for your student(s). We've partnered with Cox to connect students that do not have an internet connection at home through their affordable Connect2Compete program. This program will ensure your student(s) continue learning at home.

The Cox Connect2Compete program provides:

- First two months of free service for a limited time, \$9.95/month thereafter
- Free premium remote help desk support for a limited time to provide peace of mind and ease with new technology until May 15, 2020.
- Installation with no additional fees
- In-home Wi-Fi equipment at no additional charge

Cox is also working with PCs for People to provide discounted, refurbished computers for eligible families.

The Cox Connect2Compete program is available to families who have at least one child that attends Gretna Middle School, participate in one of these government subsidy programs: The National School Lunch Program, SNAP, TANF or Public Housing and are not a current Cox internet customer.
