### **Arrival and Dismissal**

School starts on Wednesday, August 26, 2020 for our Traditional Learners.

**Our new school hours are 7:20 a.m. to 2:10 p.m.** Car Pool riders will enter the line from Green Acres St. to Vineyard St, onto Kent Street.

beginning at 6:55 a.m. to 7:20 a.m. Tardy Bell rings at 7:30 a.m.

**Temperatures** will be taken when the students exit the car. Students who have a fever, or exhibit symptoms of illness, will return to the car with their parents to go home. Names will be submitted on a log with the Car Pool Staff and then given to the Nurse or Administrators to contact you.

Students can not return to school until screening dialogue has taken place with the nurse. Students must be free of fever for 24 hrs.

### **Please follow the following policies:**

Every student must wear a **mask** at all times.

No visitors, including parents, will be allowed on campus. If you need to come to the school, please call the school office for an appointment. 504-887-8814.

### **Supplies**

Since parents will not be able to escort students to class on the first day, we are asking that you only send a few school supplies to school each day for the opening days. You may send school supplies a few at a time over multiple days. Only send what your child can carry in their book bags.

### **Bottled Waters**

All water fountains will be covered for health and safety protection. Students can bring 1-2 clear plastic bottles of water each day. Clearly print the student's name on the bottle.

### **Hand Sanitizer**

Hand sanitizer is available throughout the school grounds and in each classroom. Students may bring a small bottle of hand sanitizer for their personal use but we are asking that they do not share any personal hand sanitizer with other students.

It is very important that we have current addresses, email addresses, and working telephone numbers for the emergency contact cards. We look forward to working with our teachers, parents, and students to keep our learning environment safe and effective. This is a work in progress during this pandemic experience and we need your support for our teaching and learning to be successful. We are counting on you.
