Program Description:

Barbering is a two-year program open to 11th and 12th grade students enrolled in a Jefferson Parish High Schools, Westbank. Students participate in academically rigorous instruction that prepares them for the State of Louisiana licensing exam and participate in the study of economics leading to MicroEnterprise Statewide Certification. Daily lessons will include lecture, note taking, independent reading, and successfully completing written tests. Hands-on instruction is provided through demonstration and practice. After extensive practice on mannequins, students will be invited to service live models and customers in our on-site Barber Shop which is equipped according to industry standards. Depending on attendance and participation, most students will meet the 1500 instructional hour qualification to sit for the Barber licensing exam, after graduation, but students should be committed to good daily attendance and working beyond the JPSchools calendar.



Students will work on following Certifications:

- IBC: Micro-Enterprise Statewide (Basic)
- Complementary: MicroEnterprise Regional
- Complementary: 300 Hours Letter
- Barber License (1500 instructional hours required)

Barbers median pay was \$35,190 per year \$16.92 per hour earn in 2019, Louisiana. (www.bls.gov)
According the Bureau of Labor Statistics approximately 48% are self-employed.



Year I Study:

Anatomy and physiology of the head, neck; infection control, decontamination and sanitation of tools; chemistry of hair, hair cutting & styling, coloring, shampooing, attire, curling and waving; facial shaving, razor techniques; rod sets, uniform layer cut, scalp & face massage, tool maintenance; financial management and customer service.

Year II Study:

Advanced hair design, hair cutting, styling and coloring.

Additional Information

The teacher will provide uniform expectations and licensing requirements the first week of school. Students will provide a copy of birth certificate, social security card and 2 pictures to submit for student license.

Cost for all materials and MicroEnterprise exam is provided by school.
