It is with great pleasure that we welcome all new and returning students to C.T. Janet this fall for another exciting and productive school year.

On Wednesday, August 7, from 1:30-3:30 p.m., C.T. Janet will kick-off the school year with a Meet and Greet for parents and students in all grades. During this time, parents and students will have an opportunity to meet and greet their new teacher(s). Parents are not allowed to go to classrooms on the first day of school; all school supplies may be brought at this time, which will significantly reduce the supplies that the students will be required to bring on the first day of school. Please label all supplies with the student's name, prior to bringing them. Please enter through the cafeteria and you will be directed to the classrooms. The first official day of school for students in grades 1-5 is Thursday, August 8. This is a full day. Pre-K and Kindergarten girls first day will be on Thursday, Aug. 15, full day. Pre-K and Kindergarten boys first day will be on Friday, Aug. 16, full day. No girls on Aug. 16. All Pre-K and Kindergarten will report to school on Monday, Aug. 19. Students are allowed on campus at 8:45 a.m., no earlier. Dismissal is at 3:50 p.m. Start your child's routine on the first day of school. Whichever way your child will be getting to school (bus, walker, carpool) do this on the first day of school so they can be properly recorded and there will be no confusion on how they will return home in the afternoon. Regular routines are critical. If using the carpool line, please display a sign with your child's name and grade in the front window written in large black letters on a sheet of paper at least 8.5" by 11" in size.
