Additional Fees: If taking courses on the UNO campus, students may also be responsible for specific course laboratory fees and a parking decal.

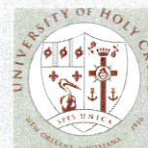
Textbook and Course Materials: Dual enrollment students are required to use the same textbooks, course materials and supplies as other University students in the same course.

All students must meet UHC's general admission requirements: Cumulative high school GPA of 2.5 or higher; minimum ACT score of 18 in English & 20 in Math, or equivalent score on UHC's ACCUPLACER placement test. Note: If students do not meet the minimum requirements, they may enroll in ENG100, REA100, MAT99, MAT100A, or MAT100B.
