



Meisler's Drop Off/Pick Up Procedures 2020-2021

Morning Drop Off:

- **Bus Riders:** The buses will enter Pharr Street and pull onto the horseshoe driveway. The buses will unload one at a time. The students will be given an index card with their bus number on it on the first day. This will let students know the bus number they are looking for at the end of the day in case they forget their bus number. The bus duty teacher will count students and direct the students to either breakfast or to their first period class. On the first day we will have additional teachers that can assist students in finding their first period class.
- **Carpool:** Car riders will enter Pharr Street and turn right onto Richland, and then turn right onto Acadia Street and wait their turn until they reach the gate. There will be a teacher on duty that will assist students exiting the car. Students will walk along the sidewalk to the horseshoe where they will be directed to either breakfast or to their first period class. Again on the first day we will have extra teachers on duty that can assist students in finding their first period class in case they have forgotten where to report. During a rainy day, you will follow the same procedure, but instead of the students walking on the sidewalk the students will enter the building next to the gate and proceed inside the building. You may not drop your student off in front of the school on rainy days. Students will not be allowed to enter through the main entry of the building on rainy days.
- **Walkers:** Students will use the crosswalk at 17th St. and Cleary Avenue to cross to Meisler. A crossing guard will be on duty before school and after school to safely cross students on Cleary Avenue. Students may not use any other crossing points to cross Cleary Avenue. Walkers will cross Cleary Avenue and proceed down the sidewalk and turn left onto Acadia Street. They will continue walking to the gate and enter the gate on Acadia Street and proceed down the sidewalk to the horseshoe where they will be directed by the teacher on duty to either go to breakfast or to their first period class. On rainy days students will continue to follow this path and enter the gate on Acadia Street and walk to the door of the building next to the gate on Acadia Street.



Afternoon Pick Ups:

- **Bus riders:** Bus riders will be called by the bus number as it is placed in order of bus line up in the main driveway of the school. Students will be called over the intercom and will be directed by their fifth period teacher to report to their bus in front of the school. Students will board their buses and the buses will be dismissed.
- **Carpoolers:** Cars will enter Pharr Street, turn right onto Richland, and turn right again onto Acadia Street and wait in line until you reach the gate to receive your child. The student will be waiting on the sidewalk for their car. Students will not be allowed to walk to a parked car on a side street. The teacher on duty will place your child in the car and you will exit on Acadia Street. These streets become one way streets in the morning and afternoons to assist families in our school. Please adhere to the signs posted on the streets and do not block driveways.
- **Walkers:** A student that is designated as a walker will be dismissed from school last. The students will exit the building from the front doors of the school and cross at the 17th St. and Cleary Avenue crossing. The crossing guard will assist with the crossing of Cleary Ave. These students may not cross at any other point on Cleary Avenue. Students may not walk to Johnny Bright park, any eating establishments on veterans highway, or cross the Cleary Avenue bridge after school. They will be turned around and have to call home for a ride.

Due to COVID-19 we will practice social distancing, and all students must wear their mask with arrival and dismissal procedures until further notice. All health & safety procedures and protocols must be followed.
