Student Bullying Prevention Video and Discussion Topics

According to the Jefferson Parish Schools Anti-Bullying Policy, students in grades 3-12 must receive age appropriate Anti-Bullying Training. This must be completed by October 31, 2019. Student training shall include viewing the video covering topics: defining bullying, skills to prevent bullying, reporting bullying, and overcoming bullying. Using the video and the Discussion Topics can fulfill this requirement.

It is highly recommended to pause the video and insert the Discussion Topics throughout the video.

Discussion Topics:

- Review the definition of bullying. (RIP- Repeated, Intentional, power-based)
- Discuss the types of bullying. (Physical, Verbal, Social-Emotional, Cyberbullying)
- Discuss how bullying makes people feel.
- Discuss what it means to be an upstander as opposed to a bystander.
- Teachers should inform the students of JPS's anti-bully policy. (See attached Policy)
- Discuss how to make a report and where to place the report if done anonymously. (See attached Bullying Anonymous Reporting Form)
- If you have 6th grade and above – Where is the Bullying Box? How does it work?
- Discuss safe adults in the school and have each student identify who they feel is a safe adult to tell about bullying.
