**Dandridge Final Settlement Agreement December 2011 Preliminary Report**

In accordance with the Final Settlement Agreement between the Jefferson Parish Public School System and Lena Vern Dandridge, et al., entered into on August 2, 2011, the parties agreed that specific information would be documented in a preliminary report in December of the first year of the agreement. This report includes data identified in the aforementioned expectations in the following areas:

1. The number of students enrolled in the Magnet Schools, Advanced Study Academies, and IBO programs by race, ethnicity (using the census reporting categories required by the Louisiana Department of Education), grade level and school. **See Attachments 1, 2 and**

**3, located at the end of this report and identified respectively as:**

- **Elementary Magnet Schools/Magnet Programs December 2011 Enrollment Report**
- **Advanced Study Academies December 2011 Enrollment Report**
- **Middle & High School IBO Programs December 2011 Enrollment Report**

NOTE: In schools where the magnet program is integrated into the entire school, the *Grade Level Enrollment* may differ from the *Total Number in Program* and/or the *Total School Enrollment* due to one or more of the following reasons:

- Students are identified with two or more races/ethnicities in Infinite Campus (Student Information System);
